Command Team Checklist (Report of a Lost or Downed Firefighter)

- Ascertain from Mayday Caller:**
 - LOCATION**
 - UNIT**
 - NAME**
 - ASSIGNMENT**
 - RESOURCES NEEDED FOR RESCUE**
- Emergency Traffic Declaration to Alert Fireground That A Mayday Has Been Declared**
- Move Non Affected Units to a Secondary Fireground Channel**
- PAR conducted by Operations on Secondary Channel**
- Immediately Request Additional Alarm(s)**
- Commit the Rapid Intervention Team**
- Change Plan to a High Priority Rescue Effort**
- Withdraw Companies from Affected Areas (As Needed)**
- Re-enforce Firefighting Positions**
- Open / Unlock All Doors**
- Ventilate - Maintain Tenability**
- Provide Additional Lighting**
- Closely Coordinate and Control Search Efforts**
- Special Call for TRT Teams if needed**
- Monitor Structural Stability**
- Maintain Strong Supervision and Control of Crews**
- Assign Additional Chief Officers to Area of Rescue**
- Control the Media**
